- To build capacity within the university for quality assurance and enhancement.

Principles

UIT University's quality assurance system is anchored in the following fundamental principles:

- **Commitment to quality:** All members of the university community are united in their unwavering commitment to achieving and maintaining the highest standards of quality in all that they do.
- **Student-centricity:** The quality of education and research always has students' interests at heart, ensuring their needs are met and their success is achieved.
- **Continuous improvement:** The university is relentlessly committed to continuous improvement, continuously striving to enhance the quality of its operations through ongoing evaluation and refinement.

- Evidence-based decision-making: Decisions about quality are informed by sound evidence gathered through systematic data collection, analysis, and interpretation.
- Transparency and accountability: The university is committed to transparency in its quality assurance processes and accountable for its performance to all stakeholders.

Framework

UIT University's quality assurance framework is built upon the following key elements:
